Initiatives - Ridgway Government Lighting

- ► Town Hall lighting survey showed 64 light fixtures but only 9 LEDs
- ► Town is buying LEDs through Green Lights program
 Town receiving a ROCC grant to cover the bulb purchase
- ➤ A small number of nimble young ROCC/CEC volunteers will safely rewire the fixtures
 - ▶ Talk to Rein or Dave to see if you might qualify!
- ▶ Town maintenance staff will do backup checks of our wiring work

Initiatives - Ouray Government Lighting

- Ouray Librarian & Library Cmtee eager to pay for LED lights (with ROCC volunteers helping with rewiring)
- ► Zoom meeting with Ouray Mayor & Acting City Administrator
 - ▶ Both expressed support but concerns with liability + checking volunteer work is too much for their busy City Maintenance staff
- ▶ We presented in November to the Ouray City Council and won unanimous council support!
 - ▶ Proposal to have Ouray pay for the LED lights (Roughly 6 month payback!)
 - ► ROCC will provide volunteers + pay for a bonded handyman to train, assist, & inspect all volunteer work

Status - Ouray

- Ouray Handyman identified and standing by
- ► Request submitted for 46 LED tubes and 4 fixed lights for the Ouray Community Library a complete lighting make-over
- ► Working with the City Resource Director to order 150 LED lights (tubes + bulbs) to replace bulbs at the Hot Springs and C. Center

however

► The Ouray Hot Springs and Gym have well over 250 bulbs that need replacement - and the Ouray Community Center has even more

Other CEC news....

- ► SMPA Totally Green program is going well --- PLEASE SIGN UP!!
 - Now, the Green Fund also provides rebates for beneficial electrification, e.g.
 - ► All Electric Homes e-Bikes!
 - ► Air Source Heat Pumps EVs & EV charging stations
 - ► Electric Hot Water Heaters Battery Systems
 - ► Tri-State is increasing their renewables while the SMPA Board is considering other electricity suppliers in a competitive process
- ▶ We continue work with the school on new LED projects
 - ▶ Prior LED bulb replacements are now saving \$14-15,000/year
- ▶ RSS Clean Energy Class won a CO grant for an EV charging station!
 - ▶ Modified the grant application we wrote for our Ridgway EV station
- ► Still working toward RSS solar....

And finally, consider this CEC proposal....

- ► In 2020, the ROCC CEC is spending roughly \$400 each on current Ridgway & Ouray government LED projects (per prior ROCC approval)
 - ▶ We are calculating outcomes (projected energy & cost savings) for all projects
 - ▶ We will use lots of volunteer labor
- ▶ Would ROCC members give the CEC a \$2000-2500 budget in 2021 to promote full LED adoption in Ouray County government and school buildings?
 - ▶ We will work to get the "most bang for the buck" & envision that all such efforts would involve contributions by all parties (money or staff time...)
 - ▶ This would allow CEC staff to more nimbly "negotiate" such projects with local government staff while building on our current momentum
