The meeting was called to order by Vicki Huggins. She asked for approval of the Minutes of the general membership meeting held December 8, 2021. Kate Kellogg moved to approve the minutes as presented. With a second by Rich Niemeier, the Minutes were approved.

Kate Kellogg and Linda Browning gave an update on the Not Spaghetti dinner. The date of June 10, 2022 has been selected and is to be held at the group event center at PaCoChuPuk in Ridgway State Park. Linda reported that she is researching the possibility of having the event catered rather than ROCC members volunteering to cook and provide food. She will have more information at the February 9, 2022 board meeting.

Kate asked for volunteers to head up the search for a speaker at the event. Roze Evans volunteered to head the speaker search. Kate stepped up to handle publicity for the event. A volunteer to head the search for the Citizen of the Year Award is still needed. Diane Thompson's band has agreed to play at the event.

Al reported that BOCC did not pass any mask orders. We learned from the recent survey to the membership on this matter that in the future we need to be clear about the purpose and use of the information received from a survey. There were a total of 34 responses to the survey with 30 in the affirmative for ROCC to give input to BOCC. As no order was passed, no response was made and the matter became moot.

Vicki reported that the ROCC September, 2022 membership meeting will be held at the TOP of the PINES in conjunction with a Dark Skies event. A specific date will be determined when we get closer to September as weather will one of the factors.

There were no committee reports and the meeting was adjourned.
