- Completed one year of photometric Dark Sky measurements
  - Helps establish a baseline from which to monitor growth in light pollution
- Provided RDSC status at Feb 13<sup>th</sup> Ridgway Town Council (TC) meeting
  - TC directed Town Staff to prioritize lighting ordinance (LO) update
  - Staff brought an outline of LO changes to the Ridgway Planning Commission March 6th
  - RDSC provided proposed roles in supporting the Town obtain and maintain IDA Dark Sky Designation
  - RDSC offered suggestions that will be needed to satisfy IDA awaiting response from the Town
- Planned and coordinated Dark Sky outreach events
